These parents can find themselves worn out and discouraged simply trying to make ends meet as well as trying to meet the mental, emotional, physical, social and spiritual needs of their children. In the Kansas- Nebraska Conference we want to be Jesus' hands and feet to encourage these single moms in their difficult situations and equip them with skills to help them successfully deal with the challenges they face.

The moms enjoy four presentations by our speaker while their children enjoy the wonderful activities provided and supervised by the camp staff...archery, crafts, nature, jet skis, swimming, bounce house, Frisbee golf, horseback riding, zipline and more. The schedule is designed for moms to also enjoy these great activities together with their children making beautiful family memories!

Each day begins and ends with the camp staff presenting lively, uplifting sing-alongs, skits and a brief worship presented by our camp pastor sharing stories illustrating how Jesus is our best friend and Savior! Moms and kids are refreshed, encouraged, make new friends, and take home practical ideas to improve their lives and those of their children.

One mom, who used to attend this retreat, but is now married, brings every mom a nice tote bag full of practical personal care items and each child a small

tote bag of fun toys. She works all year to collect items and solicits donations from other church members. It makes the ladies feel special to receive the lovely filled tote bags.

In order for these moms to be able to afford the retreat the cost is kept very low. We charge \$40 per mom and \$15 per child for this Thursday afternoon through Sunday morning retreat. The Conference subsidizes this retreat to keep it affordable. We encourage our churches to sponsor their single mom families and give them gas money for their trip to camp.

These moms leave encouraged, better able to face their challenging circumstances. One mom shared her experience in this way... "It is so good to be able to sit back and relax knowing the kids are safe and having fun. We are going to try to come every year! The kids have a blast with all the activities and songs! I love all of the sermonettes! We look forward to seeing you next year."

One mom, who was especially appreciative, shared that she had been out of the SDA church for twenty years, but was now coming back and so thankful for having been able to come to the retreat. She especially connected with the camp pastor.

May God bless you as you consider how you can minister to these wonderful, but challenged families.
