# Anna's Leadership

(The following is a part of the devotional Dr. Rene Mobley presented at the ASAM advisory during the Adventist Ministries Convention in Tucson, Arizona, in January of 2017.)

Luke 2:36-38 talks about a person that showed the 4 principles that are a must for being a leader for the Lord. This is the story of Anna and her being a woman is a plus (that is meant for a smile, not a dig). In unpacking the story of Anna, there are 4 principles we will look at.

#### \*\*\*A\*\*\* AVAILABLE.

For Anna to make herself available, I feel sure was not an easy thing to do. Her family lineage was from Phanuel, the place where Jacob wrestled with the angel. Despite all the blessings bestowed on the tribe of Asher, Anna's tribe, the tribe failed to help drive out the Canaanites when God commanded. They failed to trust in God and honor His plan. This lack of trust was grounded in fear, therefore, Anna had the blood of fear running through her veins. Also, Anna was a widow after only seven years of marriage and at 84 had no sons to take care of her, no home, no social security or Medicare. She certainly had reason to say to God, "For sure you are going to have to get someone else Lord, because you must have forgotten that I am a woman living in a time when it isn't accepted or expected for a women to be called and used by God." But none of this stopped her from making

herself AVAILABLE which leads us to our next principal. (Read more.)

#### \*\*\*N\*\*\* NON-CONFORMIST

Our sister Anna understood Romans 12:2, "Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God". Like Anna, we can't allow ourselves to be drawn into how things have always been. If this is not how God is calling us to lead, then we can't allow other's "mediocre is good enough" way of doing things to rub off on us when God has called us to Excellence. Also, like Anna, we can't allow fear of what others my say, how they may react or their attempts to block progress cause you to conform because, as we know, God didn't give us the spirit of fear. Now for the 3rd of Anna's leadership principal.

#### \*\*\*N\*\*\* NEED

I firmly believe that God called Anna because she was a forward thinking person. She didn't wait for someone to vote her in or to have a committee meeting. When she heard the voice of God and He revealed to her a need, she moved into action. She saw the need for someone to not leave the temple, to fast and pray, and speak of God to all who looked for redemption in Jerusalem. She didn't question her talents and abilities, nor did she do as we southerners do and say, "I am fixin to." When she saw the need, she went into turbo mode which leads us to our final principal.

#### \*\*\*A\*\*\* ATTITUDE

Anna possessed an attitude of gratitude in living by "In everything give thanks". This is the sign of a Good-Great Leader. As we look at Anna and her situation, we can she had every reason to just have a not so good attitude, however; making herself AVAILABLE, having a NON-CONFORMIST mindset, being up the challenge when a NEED presented itself, all gave her the ATTITUDE that "All things work together for my good", so I will "Praise the Lord at all time and His praise shall continually be in my mouth". God is calling you, me, all of us to have The ANNA APPROACH to our leadership for the work of Christ.

# Preschool Shyness Study at the University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland

Drs. Andrea Chronis-Tus cano and Kenneth Rubin are conducting a National Institute of Mental Health-funded study examining two early intervention programs for shy children ages 45 to 64 months (3 years, 9 months - 5 years, 4 months) and their parents. Research has found that both programs are effective in helping children feel less nervous in social situations.
